What is Vertical Tutoring?

Why move to Vertical Tutoring?

- Students are better supported
- Every student is well known
- Better communication between staff and with parents
- Parents are better equipped to support students at home
- It creates a family approach to tutor time
- Different age groups work together to support each other which breaks down age barriers
- Greater opportunities for student leadership
- Improved attainment

Year 7 (6 tutor groups of 30 students, each tutor group will contain a mixture of Houses)



HOUSE 1

HOUSE 2

It will contain 8 tutor groups of 22/23 students. Students will be a mixture of Year 8, Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11.



HOUSE 3

It will contain 8 tutor groups of 22/23 students. Students will be a mixture of Year 8, Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11.



HOUSE 4

It will contain 8 tutor groups of 22/23 students. Students will be a mixture of Year 8, Year 9, Year 10 and Year 11.
