

Y11 leavers 2016

Current data shows that this year 179/181 (2 returned to their home countries) of our Y11 students made an application to FTE or EAT. The vast majority of students have applied to further education and data to confirm our students' destination after Chesterton will be released shortly. To date, CRC and Long Road have provided their enrolment numbers (available on request).

New data is published in November.

School leavers 2015

96.7% of our students opted for FTE

0% entered into EAT

1.1% are NEET (approximately 2 students)

0.6% are in voluntary or part-time work

0.6% moved out of area

1.1% are classed as unknown

NEET figures

1.1% of our Y11 leavers 2015 are NEET (of which 1.1% male, 1.1% female) but we are significantly below the NEET rates for England.

NEET rates for different age cohorts: England 2013 – 2015

NEET data for Cambridge City is 1.8% and all of CAP is 1.9%

School leavers 2014

95.9% of our students opted for FTE

0.6% of our students entered into EAT

0.6% are in voluntary or part-time work

0.6% are NEET

1.2% moved out of area

1.2% are classed as unknown

NEET figures

0.6% of our Y11 leavers 2014 are NEET (of which 1.2% male, 0% female)

In comparison with last year, this is an improvement as 2.0% of 2013 leavers were classed as NEET (all female).

NEET data for all of CAP is 1.1% and Cambridge City is 2.4%
