ASSESSMENT GUIDANCE

Your assessment will last for 50 minutes. You will be given an extract from the Hunger Games, and an extract from an unseen text. You will then need to write an analytical response comparing similarities and differences between the two texts. You are being tested on your ability to understand the sources, to select quotations from them, to analyse the language and structure used, to comment on context, and to write comparatively.

These questions will be based on the content as set out in the revision list below.
